Outdoor Learning

Our children continue learning outdoors in all weather conditions. If the weather is forecast to be sunny, please send your child with a sunhat and ensure that sun-cream has been applied before nursery school. Please sign the consent form which is in each classroom.

Reminder: Seedlings Funded Hours and Fees

With the introduction of 15 funded hours from 9 months old in September, parents may wish to book full-day, school day or half-day sessions as top-ups. From September 2024, our fees will be:

£60 for 8am- 5:45pm, £48 for the school day (8:45am to 3:15pm) and £24 for a 3 hour morning or afternoon session. Our fees information will be updated and sent out to all parents.

Late Collection

We have a clear policy in place for collection at the end of the session. Children must be collected by 11:45am or 3:15pm. The doors are opened 5 minutes before this time. If you are late, then staff are being asked to work beyond their contracted hours and it is upsetting for children. After 3 late collections, there will be a late fee of £10 applied if late collection is not an emergency and the office have been informed.
